About DLCC:

Thank you for your interest in the Democratic Legislative Campaign Committee (DLCC). The Committee's goal is to provide strategic services and financial assistance to Democratic Leaders and candidates at the state legislative level.

The work of the DLCC became increasingly vital in the volatile political climate of the late 1990's. In 1994, Democrats lost several state legislative chambers, and many of these losses can be attributed to an inability or unwillingness to adapt to new political circumstances. The DLCC's role is to upgrade and modernize Democratic tactics so that candidates can maintain a competitive edge. Ultimately, the DLCC aims to build modern, state-of-the-art campaign committees across the country.

Since its creation, the DLCC has made enormous strides. Most recently, in the November 2006 elections, Democrats at the state legislative level achieved a net pickup of 10 legislative chambers. Democrats now control 55 chambers while Republicans control 41 chambers. Democrats are making gains at the legislative level because we have revitalized state campaign committees and are running modern, efficient campaigns.

Program Information:

Internship : DLCC has at least one internship position available for the Fall and Spring semesters and a maximum of four internship positions available for the summer.

Location: 1401 K Street, NW, Washington, DC. One block from McPherson Square Metro, Blue and Orange Lines; five blocks from Farragut North Metro, Red Line

Duration: 10 weeks, Summer internships should begin no later than June 4th.

Stipend: DLCC offers the Klindt/Dye Scholarship to each intern selected. The stipend amount varies each semester.

Summer – March 31st

Specific Intern Qualifications:

- Rising 3rd or 4th year university student
- Interest in electoral politics
- Computer literacy, ability to use an assortment of software packages and familiarity with internet research
- Ability to function in a fast paced, hectic work environment
- Ability to juggle multiple tasks and to work independently
- Ability to work full time (summer interns only)
- Campaign Experience a plus, but not required

While some of the intern's duties will be administrative, each intern will be given substantive projects based on the interests and experience of each individual and the current needs of the office. [Summer interns will work extensively on four of the committee's major events which take place in July and August.] DLCC is committed to ensuring that each intern gains a valuable experience.
